1) Read:

-- CCC #1422 – 1498 (The Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation)

2a) Teach:

-- Your children about Advent and that it is a time to prepare our souls for Christmas and the birth of Jesus.

-- We are awaiting the coming of Christ.

2b) Teach:

-- Your children that Confession is how our sins after Baptism are forgiven.

-- Your children that God is merciful and will forgive any sin as long as we are sorry and intend to reject that sin in the future.

- -- Do leave them during the Christmas Season until Epiphany.
- -- Go to Confession during Advent.

5b) Do:

-- Listen to your children recite the Ten Commandments in order.

6) Homework:

- -- See that your children complete any assigned homework.
- -- Have your children memorize the Act of Contrition.
