POPE BENEDICT XVI ON THE VIRTUAL CULTURE

Some years ago (on January 24th, 2009), Pope Benedict spoke about the digital world & how it has changed the way we interact with each other & created a new virtual culture. His talk was entitled "New Technologies, New Relationships. Promoting a Culture of Respect, Dialogue & Friendship." The Pope noted that in the early life of the Church, the great Apostles & their disciples brought the Good News of Jesus to the Greek & Roman world. At that time, a fruitful evangelization required that careful attention be given to understanding the culture & customs of those pagan peoples so that the truth of the gospel would touch their hearts and minds. In a similar way today, the proclamation of Christ today requires a profound knowledge of this world if the technologies are to serve our mission adequately. Pope Benedict said that in particular, this work falls to young people, who have an almost spontaneous affinity for the new means of communication. He urged them to take on the responsibility for the evangelization of this "digital continent." He said, "Be sure to announce the Gospel to your contemporaries with enthusiasm. You know their fears & their hopes, their aspirations & their disappointments: the greatest gift you can give to them is to share with them the "Good News" of a God who became man, who suffered, died & rose again to save all people. Human hearts are yearning for a world where love

endures, where gifts are shared, where unity is built, where freedom

finds meaning in truth, & where identity is found in respectful communion. Our faith can respond to these expectations: may you become its heralds!" These words of Pope Benedict could apply to us all. Let us be eager to share our Catholic faith with those whom God places in our lives.
