GOOGLE PROMOTES ABORTION & CENSORING PRO-LIFE CONTENT

The world's largest search engine, Google, has been promoting pro-abortion content & suppressing pro-life information. This is according to a recent study in the Media Research Center's Free Speech America. The study found that a Google search for the word "pregnancy" directed users to Planned Parenthood, while the same search on other search engines (such as Bing and DuckDuckGo) would direct users to more neutral sites, such as Heathline or the Mavo Clinic. Content about women who have regretted their abortions was buried at the bottom of Google's seach results. Google has banned Live Action's pro-life ads about the abortion pill reversal. Also, Google & YouTube (which is owned by Google) have repeatedly censored pro-life content from sites such as LifeSiteNews, EWTN, Created Equal, Life Issues Institute, & Live Action. They do this by flagging

content with labels such as "medical misinformation" or by burying pro-life sources deep in search results while putting pro-abortion content at the top. (Source: Life Issues Institute "Big Tech Pushes Women toward Abortion" Nov. 9. 2023).
