FROM THE PASTOR

BLESSED PALMS

Blessed Palms are sacramentals. The palm is a symbol of victory over sin and also of our triumphal entry into heaven. Place your new palms in a prominent place within your home such as behind your crucifix. Last year's palms should either be burned or buried in a garden.

HOLY WEEK

Holy Week is upon us and with it the special liturgies of the Sacred Triduum. Join with us and the whole Church as we celebrate these most sacred Liturgies which call to mind our blessed Lord's suffering, death and resurrection.

HOLY WEEK LITURGIES

As in past years, our celebration of the Sacred Triduum will alternate between Saint Patrick's and Saint Luke's. Daily Mass on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday will follow our regular schedule. The Chrism Mass will be celebrated at 5:30pm on Monday at the Cathedral of Our Lady in Duluth. There will be Stations of the Cross and Benediction on Wednesday at Saint Patrick's at 5:30pm. (there will not be a soup supper). On Holy Thursday, the Mass of the Lord's Supper will be celebrated at Saint Patrick's at 7pm. This will be followed by Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament until 10 pm. On Good Friday, the Celebration of the Lord's Passion will be at Saint Luke's at 3pm. Stations of the Cross with a short homily will be at Saint Patrick's at 5:30pm. On Holy Saturday, the Easter Vigil will be at Saint Patrick's and will begin at 8:30pm. Easter Sunday Masses will follow our regular Sunday schedule.

COMMUNAL PENANCE THIS SUNDAY

There will be a Communal Penance Service this Sunday, April 13th from 6:00 to 7:00pm at Saint Patrick's. Two priests will be hearing confessions. There will also be a Communal Penance Service at Immaculate Conception in Pine City on Tuesday, April 15th from 6:30 to 7:30pm. These are excellent opportunities for you to go to Confession before Easter.

HOLY WEEK CONFESSIONS

Everyone is urged to use the Sacrament of Penance in preparation for Easter. Besides our regular times, we will be having extra times for Confessions during Holy Week. These are listed below:

CHRISM MASS

Each year, a special Mass is celebrated at the Cathedral where Bishop Daniel will bless and consecrate the holy oils used for the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, Anointing of the Sick and Holy Orders. At that Mass, all of the priests of the Diocese gather and renew the promises

they made at their ordination. Representatives from all of the parishes in the Diocese also attend, and at the end of Mass, they come forward to bring the oils for their particular parishes back home to be used for the coming year. I would encourage all who can to attend this special Mass. It will begin at 5:30pm. on Monday, April 3rd at the Cathedral of Our Lady in Duluth.

NO ADORATION THIS WEEK

Please note that there will not be Adoration this week at either Saint Luke's on Holy Thursday or at Saint Patrick's on Good Friday.

PLEASE REMEMBER ...

Good Friday is a day of Fast and Abstinence. Those over 14 must abstain from eating meat and those between the ages of 18 and 59 must fast.
