On his father's side, Pope Leo has French and African ancestry. His father's parents were Creole and lived in New Orleans. For that reason, Catholics from New Orleans are ecstatic and are calling Pope Leo our first black pope. Catholics from Chicago are also ecstatic and have pictures of the Pope attending a World Series game when the White Sox were in the Series back in 2005. Pope Leo is a member of the Augustinian Religious Order and was a missionary for many years in Peru. He also served as a bishop in that country. He has served the past several years as head of the Congregation of Bishops which is a department in the Vatican that helps the Pope choose new bishops when a diocese becomes vacant.
