## **FROM THE PASTOR**

### **POPE LEO XIV**

Habemus Papem! We have a pope! Not only do we have a pope, but we have a pope who was born in America, in Chicago, in fact. For various reasons, I did not think the cardinals would choose someone from America. However, that's what they did. Pope Leo has an interesting story. On his father's side, Pope Leo has French and African ancestry. His father's parents were Creole and lived in New Orleans. For that reason, Catholics from New Orleans are ecstatic and are calling Pope Leo our first black pope. Catholics from Chicago are also ecstatic and have pictures of the Pope attending a World Series game when the White Sox were in the Series back in 2005. Pope Leo is a member of the Augustinian Religious Order and was a missionary for many years in Peru. He also served as a bishop in that country. Besides English, he speaks Italian, Spanish and Portuguese. He also knows Latin and German. He has served the past several years as head of the Congregation of Bishops which is a department in the Vatican that helps the Pope choose new bishops when a diocese becomes vacant. Pope Leo will need our prayers as he begins his ministry as the 267<sup>th</sup> pope and the 266<sup>th</sup> successor to Saint Peter. He is tasked with bringing the gospel to the whole world. That means he must not only lead Catholics to God, but also invite all peoples and nations to embrace Jesus Christ who is the way and the truth and the life. May God grant him the grace to fulfill his Petrine mission.
