SOLEMNITY OF THE ASCENSION

The Solemnity of the Ascension commemorates Christ's return to His Father in heaven forty days after Jesus rose from the dead. In Minnesota, this feast is celebrated on the Seventh Sunday of Easter. Some other regions in the Country celebrate it on Ascension Thursday. We should imitate Jesus in all things, and this great feast reminds us that just as Jesus returned to the Father, we too should look forward to that day when God calls us home. Since heaven is our home, don't fall so much in love with your earthly home that you fail to look forward to heaven and to that time when you too will ascend to our Father in heaven.

SACRED HEART DEVOTIONS

Traditionally, the month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The heart has always been a sign of love, and the Sacred Heart of Jesus is a symbol of our Lord's love for us. When Jesus appeared to Saint Margaret Mary, He made several promises to her. He promised that wherever His image should be exposed with a view to showing it special honor, He would pour forth His blessings and graces. He also promised that He would grant the grace of final repentance to all those who would receive Holy Communion on the First Friday of nine consecutive months (confession also being highly recommended). This coming Friday, June 6th, is the first Friday of the month. Why not start the nine First Fridays beginning this Friday. Mass that day will be at Saint Patrick's at 6:30pm.
