FROM THE PASTOR

THE SOLEMNITY OF PENTECOST

Today we celebrate the great Solemnity of Pentecost. After Easter and Christmas, this feast is third in order of importance in the Church year. Pentecost comes fifty days after Easter and marks the end of the Easter Season. That means on Monday, we resume Ordinary Time. Pentecost has such great prominence in the life of the Church because it commemorates the Holy Spirit's descent upon the Apostles. In the Acts of the Apostles, we read that while the Apostles were gathered together, the sound of a mighty wind was heard, and then the Holy Spirit came to them as tongues of fire. Those flames symbolized the burning love God has for us (and the red vestments worn on Pentecost also remind us of this). The Holy Spirit gave abundant gifts to the Apostles and continues to do so for all those who are Confirmed in His grace. These gifts increase and deepen the baptismal graces we have received. They connect and unite us in an ever closer way to God our Father. They unite us more firmly to Christ. They increase the presence of the Holy Spirit in us, and they unite us more intensely to the Church. By these gifts, we are given strength to spread and defend our faith by word and action. Therefore, as we celebrate this great feast, let us be mindful of the many gifts we have received from the Holy Spirit both in Baptism and especially in Confirmation. Let us also ask the Holy Spirit to renew and increase in us His gifts of wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord. You can read more about the Holy Spirit in the Catechism of the Catholic Church #1285-1321, 797-801, and 1830-1832.
