FROM THE PASTOR

Each year, the Second Sunday in the Octave of Easter is celebrated as Divine Mercy Sunday in Catholic Churches throughout the world. When we celebrate the Divine Mercy, we are reminded of the lessons that we learned through our Lenten penances and Easter celebration. Everything Jesus endured and taught leads us into a rightly ordered relationship with the Father, who is Love.

Divine Mercy is celebrated on the eighth day of the Easter Octave. Easter is such an important day that we celebrate it for eight days. This is a way to liturgically emphasize the importance of the Paschal Mystery. Further “8” is a significant number as, in Jewish thought, is symbolic of eternity. So, when we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday, we’re reminded that Jesus gave us this feast through St. Faustina Kowalska to remind us that He wants us to be with Him in Heaven for all eternity.

Celebrating Divine Mercy on the 8th day in the Octave of Easter is also a reminder of God’s burning desire to extend His mercy whenever we repent of our sins and its tie to Jesus’ salvific passion, death, and Resurrection. As of late, it seems more clear than ever that the world is actually craving Jesus who is the Way, the Truth, and the Life. The more chaotic and sinful the world becomes, the more people of the world are drawn to the solid and consistent message of the Gospel.

Jesus’ message is very attractive to a world caught in sin. The world offers momentary pleasure and fleeting glory. Jesus offers true peace and everlasting life. His mercy is available to all who repent and turn away from sin. We instinctively know that sin is bad for us. As St. Thomas Aquinas noted, sin steals our joy and darkens the intellect. Sin is contrary to our nature as we’ve been created in the image and likeness of God.

The more we realize the horrors of sin, the more we appreciate the mercy of God. When we realize that, on our own, we don’t deserve the good things that God gives to us, we grow in gratitude for God’s goodness. When we understand the reality of His goodness, we find ourselves being drawn more deeply into a prayerful relationship with the Lord who gave everything for our salvation. God showers us with His grace and blessings because He is good, not because we are.

The Divine Mercy devotion reminds us that God has blessed us beyond our human understanding. I think most of us are familiar with the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, through which we plead for an outpouring of God’s mercy on us and on the whole world. Often prayed at 3:00 pm, the Hour of Mercy, we recall Jesus’ death on the cross which won salvation for us. As part of our devotion to the Lord’s Divine Mercy, I invite you to join me at 3:00 at St. Patrick’s to offer a simple Chaplet of Divine Mercy.

Through the Divine Mercy devotion, we keep in mind that after we ask for God’s mercy, we then extend His mercy to those around us as an imitation of Jesus. We’re further called to completely trust in His mercy because He is trustworthy. The Divine Mercy devotion helps us to see our need for His mercy and forgiveness and leads to our trust that His offer of eternal life is true! For the Sake of His sorrowful passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.
